CHALLENGES

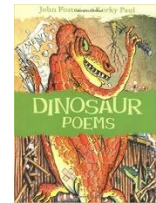

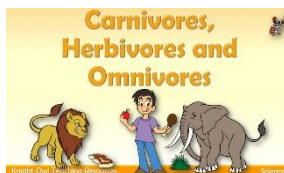
Find some stories that have dinosaurs as characters. Read the stories, choose your favourite one and then write about it. What did you like? Who was your favourite character? Why?
